Trustee Carr Report:

1. Architectural bids are due Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> for the fire department
2. 4<sup>th</sup> of July – Olmsted Falls parade will occur
3. Attended an ODOT meeting on June 28 during which it was found that they have \$24mil to spend on various road projects.

Trustee Bush Report:

1. Met with head of human resources for Cuyahoga County for which there will be hearings. Mayors and trustees will attend re: tying into Cuyahoga County benefits program, which could be a better cost alternative. A meeting will be held July 7, 2010 from 9:00-11:00 at Metrohealth Medical Center.
2. Chaired cemetery board meeting held the previous week. Appointed Gary Thompson to fill the term vacated by Linda Garrity. First order of business is to complete the barn in the most cost-effective way.
