

RESOLUTION NO. 041-2017

Off-Duty Firefighter Rate of Pay and Equipment Fee Structure

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be it Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township, that

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire has received requests to provide life safety duties and services at various venues in Olmsted Township, and;

WHEREAS, if there is a need to staff these venues with firefighter/paramedics with or without motorized equipment, a standard rate of pay for the firefighter/paramedics and fee for the use of the equipment be determined and passed along to the agency hosting the event, and;

WHEREAS, the rate of pay for the firefighters will be \$30/hour for a firefighter and \$33/hour for an officer with a three hour minimum. The cost of the use of motorized apparatus is based on the following formula:

Total Cost of Apparatus / (Life expectancy in years * Average work hours per year) = Average Cost per Hour

Utilizing this formula, the proposed Costs would be as follows:

Apparatus	Total Cost	Life Expectancy (years)	Average Work Hours/Year	Average Cost/Hour
Pumping Engine	\$400,000	20	200	\$100.00
Ambulance	\$175,000	8	650	\$33.65

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the fire department adopt the aforementioned rate of pay scale for the use of Olmsted Township firefighter/paramedics and motorized apparatus fees when requested and/or be required to provide staffing at township venues;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
