



IMPORTANT ROADWAY PROJECT NOTICE TO THE OLMSTED TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS IN OUR BRENTWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co. Inc. has been awarded the contract to do some full depth concrete replacement in the Villages of Lakeside and your neighborhood. The two main roadways that will be repaired in the Brentwood Neighborhood are Glenbrook and Skyline Drives. With all this work being performed, all services, Police, Fire, mail and trash will be maintained, with no interruption of services.

The concrete replacement project in the Villages is due to begin the week of June 12th and work will begin in the Brentwood Neighborhood, the week of June 19th.

The first roadway to be repaired will be Glenbrook. Saw cutting will be the first task you will see happen, other than the barrels being put into place. Traffic will be one way, north bound only, until Glenbrook is completed. This roadway will have full depth concrete repair as well as all the joints removed and all areas set back with concrete. There will be several catch basins re-built as well as a new section of sidewalk also set. Once Glenbrook is completed, Skyline will be one way to traffic, west bound only, with very similar work being performed on this section of roadway as well. This project is expected to take 3-4 weeks, with the weather being a factor. There are two message boards that are in place and the messages will be changed as the project dictates, so the residents and motorists will know what to expect.

Plan on using Brentwood and Kingswood, off of Usher Road and Brentwood, off of Bagley Road as new alternates during construction.

We have not done a roadway project in Olmsted Township since Oxford Park Drive, in 2005. Thanks to the levy that was passed in 2014, this Board of Trustees has made our failing infrastructures, their priority! We will have a "5-year Capital Roadway Plan" to our residents by Summer of 2018.
