## IMPORTANT ROADWAY PROJECT NOTICE TO OUR OLMSTED TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS IN OUR VILLAGES OF LAKESIDE NEIGHBORHOOD

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co. Inc. has been awarded the contract to do some full depth concrete replacement in your neighborhood as well as some more extensive roadway repair in our Brentwood Neighborhood. The concrete replacement in the Villages is due to begin the week of June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017. All traffic and services, including Police, Fire, mail and trash will continue as normal. There are three major areas that the contract addresses and they all intersect with the Parkway. They are at Arbor Lane, Glenside Lane and Arbor Court. There will be a message board up on Pineswood Way entering the Villages to remind the residents as well as their guests that may be visiting them of the construction in this area.

Besides these intersection replacements, there will be some other full depth roadway replacement, as well as some catch basin repairs in isolated areas throughout your neighborhood, but again, no interruption of services! Additional door hangers will be used to identify those additional areas of repair, so residents will be aware.

Suggested alternate route to avoid congestion: Use Laurel Lane to Stearns Road and the West entrance of the Village Parkway, opposite Hall's Brothers until the project is completed.

We have not done a roadway project in Olmsted Township since Oxford Park Drive, in 2005. Thanks to the levy that was passed in 2014, this Board of Trustees has made our failing infrastructures, their priority! We will have a "5-year Capital Roadway Plan" to our residents by Summer of 2018.
