Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township that



WHEREAS, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees has determined that there is a need to certify with the County Fiscal Officer, pursuant to original Resolution 04-2009, which stipulates that Olmsted Township commenced a program to have Allied Waste Management bill the residents of Olmsted Township directly for waste removal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olmsted Township, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio, that it has been determined that the new residential dwellings who were not certified on the 2016 or 2017 special assessment have remained unpaid will be certified with the County Fiscal Officer and placed on the residents tax bill as a special assessment in accord with section 505.33, authorizing the Township to certify delinquent waste collection accounts to the County Fiscal Officer, and have the unpaid charges placed on the tax duplicate for the ensuing year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
