

RESOLUTION NO. 141-2017

Recognition of Chief of Police Matthew Vanyo – Amending Resolution 62-2016

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township that

WHEREAS, Matt Vanyo has been serving as the Police Chief of Olmsted Township since May 1, 2016, and has successfully completed his probationary period, and;

WHEREAS, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees believes that Chief Matthew Vanyo deserves a merit based increase in compensation based on his performance in his role as Police Chief.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olmsted Township, State of Ohio, is pleased to increase Chief Matthew Vanyo's salary from \$80,000.00 to \$85,000.00 annually effective the week of November 5, 2017.

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The position of Olmsted Township Police Chief is hereby designated FLSA exempt and for purposes of public accountability shall be expected to adhere to a workweek of at least forty (40) hours of work per week with a normal schedule as directed by the Board of Trustees/designee.
2. The position of Police Chief shall be entitled to those same benefits as are provided to full-time non-bargaining unit personnel under the Township Policy Manual as adopted or revised.
3. The terms of this resolution constitute conditions of employment and shall not be construed as a contract.
4. Any and all prior resolutions governing the compensation, benefits, and other terms and conditions of employment for the position of Police Chief are hereby repealed. This includes, but is not limited to Resolution 61-2012, 50-2016, and 62-2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
