

Resolution 147-2017

Submission of FY -2018 Community Development Supplemental Grant Program Application

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees that:

WHEREAS, Olmsted Township is eligible to apply for Community Development Supplemental Grant Program administered by Cuyahoga County Department of Development to assist municipalities with a variety of projects related to promote the health and welfare of the community.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that Olmsted Township is eligible to apply for these funds which will enable the Township to maximize dollars by combining financial resources and applying grant funds to effectuate the completion of a new service complex, specifically a salt storage facility and a storm water quality basin for the service complex.

WHEREAS, The site, located at 7900 Fitch Road, formerly housed the engineering division of Cuyahoga County Public Works service garage. The building, now owned and operated by Olmsted Township, is approximately 6,250 square feet and was constructed in 1940. The age of the building will require major repairs to ensure its safety and functionality. The repairs include, but are not limited to: a new roof, updated electrical & plumbing, new HVAC, and foundation improvement/stabilization at a total cost of \$853,000.

WHEREAS, Olmsted Township is currently in the process of developing a fully functional service complex. This complex will provide responsive, effective, and professional day-to-day services to enhance the quality of life for our residents and increase economic development opportunities for our community and to Cuyahoga County as a whole, and as such, will promote the health and welfare of Olmsted Township and its residents.

WHEREAS, investing in Olmsted Township's ability to maintain its infrastructure has benefits to Cuyahoga County as preserving, maintaining, and investing in infrastructure will help the region in sustaining positive economic development efforts, and as such, will also promote the health and welfare of Olmsted Township and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED: that the Board of Trustees of Olmsted Township authorizes the submission of the FY 2018 Community Development Supplemental Grant Program (marked as Exhibit A and attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten herein).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
