

RESOLUTION NO. 174-2018

Appoint A. Malloy to Police Department Part-Time

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be it Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township, that

WHEREAS, a need exists within the Olmsted Township Police Department to hire a replacement part-time police officer, and to establish the working conditions of the part-time officer;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olmsted Township, State of Ohio, that:

Alexander Malloy is appointed to the position of part-time patrol officer within the Olmsted Township Police Department, and to satisfy the patrolman requirements of the position as a condition of employment. This appointment shall take effect on November 18, 2018.


FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. Alexander Malloy shall be entitled to all contractual benefits according to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement (Part-Time Patrol), and he shall serve a twelve (12) month probationary period.
2. Alexander Malloy shall not work an hours in excess of 1,040 hours annually.
3. Alexander Malloy shall serve at the Pleasure of the Board of Trustees, and shall not be entitled to any fringe benefits (medical, dental, etc.).
4. Alexander Malloy will receive the 0-1 year hourly rate for wages as established by the current Collective Bargaining Agreement (Part-time Patrol).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
