Recognition of Chief of Police Matthew Vanyo

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township that

WHEREAS, Matthew Vanyo has been serving as the Chief of Police of Olmsted Township since March 23, 2016, and;

WHEREAS, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees and Township Administrator believes that Matthew Vanyo deserves a merit based increase based on his performance in his role as Chief of Police.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olmsted Township, State of Ohio, is pleased to increase Chief of Police Matthew Vanyo salary by 3.5% effective April 21, 2019.




**FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The position of Chief of Police is hereby designated FLSA exempt and for purposes of public accountability shall be expected to adhere to a workweek of at least forty (40) hours of work per week with a normal schedule as directed by the Board of Trustees/designee.
2. The position of Chief of Police shall be entitled to those same benefits as are provided to full-time non-bargaining unit personnel under the Township Policy Manual as adopted or revised.
3. The terms of this resolution constitute conditions of employment and shall not be construed as a contract.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED;** that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
