

**RESOLUTION NO. 122-2019**

*Appoint Part-Time Firefighter James Bittel*

**Cuyahoga** County, Ohio

**Be it Resolved** by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township, that

**WHEREAS**, a need exists within the Olmsted Township Fire Department to hire a part-time firefighter/ paramedic, and to establish the working conditions of the part-time firefighter/ paramedic;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Olmsted Township, State of Ohio, that:

James Bittel is appointed to the position of part-time firefighter/ paramedic within the Olmsted Township Fire Department, and to satisfy the firefighter/ paramedic requirements of the position as a condition of employment. This appointment shall take starting on or after Sunday, July 28, 2019 upon successful completion of criminal background check, pre-employment drug and alcohol test/screen, and pre-employment physical.

**FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:**

1. James Bittel shall serve a twelve (12) month probationary period.
2. James Bittel shall not work an hours in excess of 1,560 hours annually.
3. James Bittel shall serve at the Pleasure of the Board of Trustees, and shall not be entitled to any fringe benefits (medical, dental, etc.).
4. James Bittel will receive the hourly rate \$16.50.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED;** that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
