

# RESOLUTION 185-2019

*Establishing Olmsted Township as a Limited Home Rule Government and Urban Township*

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

**Be It Resolved** by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township

**WHEREAS**, this date, Dec. 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019, Trustee Zver moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, Ohio R.C. 504.01 authorizes the Board of Trustees to adopt a limited home rule government for Olmsted Township, and;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to R.C. 504.01(A)(3), the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees held a public hearing on July 10, 2019, at 6:30 pm to consider adoption of the limited home rule form of government, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has determined that the establishment of a limited home rule government will benefit the residents of Olmsted Township as well as the organization and administration of Olmsted Township governance and services, and;

**WHEREAS**, Olmsted Township has a population of fifteen thousand or more in the unincorporated territory of the Township, for purposes of R.C. 504.01(A)(3) and (B).

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board that:

1. Pursuant to R.C. 504.01(A)(3), the Board of Trustees hereby establishes a limited home rule government for Olmsted Township under which the Township may exercise limited powers of local self-government and limited police powers as authorized by Chapter 504 of the Ohio Revised Code.
2. Pursuant to R.C. 504.01(B), Olmsted Township shall be called an "urban township."
3. This Resolution shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption unless within that thirty (30) day period a petition is presented to the Board of Trustees that complies with R.C. 504.01(A)(3)(a), requesting the Board of Trustees to submit the question of establishing a limited home rule government to the electors.

Trustee Kress seconded the Motion, and thereupon, the votes in favor of this Resolution were recorded and reflected by the signatures hereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
