

RESOLUTION 088-2020

Establishing Olmsted Township Transient Vendor Permit Process, Regulations and No-solicitation Registry

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township

WHEREAS, this date, June 10, 2020, Trustee Zver moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.94 authorizes the Board of Township Trustees (“Board”) to require that transient vendors operating within Olmsted Township (the “Township”) register with the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it is in the best interests of the residents of the Township to have transient vendors register with the Board, for notification and other informational and regulatory purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees that:

1. For purposes of this Resolution, a “transient vendor” shall mean any person who opens a temporary place of business for the sale of goods or who, on the streets or while traveling about the township, sells or offers for sale goods, solicits order for future delivery of goods, or attempts to arrange an appointment for a future estimates or sales call. “Transient vendor” does not include any person who represents any entity exempt from taxation or any person licensed under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4707 (regulating auctioneers).
2. Before any transient vendor proceeds to conduct any operations in the Township, that transient vendor shall first register with the Board, using a form prescribed by the Board. The required forms, and processing of registrations, shall be available during normal business hours (Monday through Thursday, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.) at the Township Offices, 7900 Fitch Road, Olmsted Township, Ohio 44138; Phone: (440) 235-3051.
3. Each transient vendor registered with the Township will be assigned a Registration Number, and the registration shall be valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date of registration.

4. Each transient vendor will be required to pay a registration fee of \$150.00 at the time of registration.

5. Transient vendors shall be prohibited from soliciting at any residence where the owner, tenant or other occupant has posted a sign, decal, placard or other form of notice on the property prohibiting solicitation.

6. In addition, transient vendors shall be prohibited from soliciting at any residence where the owner, tenant or other occupant has filed a no solicitation registration form with the Township. A list of the properties to which no solicitation is applicable under this paragraph will be provided to each transient vendor at the time of registration.

7. Solicitation by home visits by transient vendors who have duly registered with the Board is authorized during the following times: Monday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Home solicitation is prohibited at all times on Sunday with the Township.


8. No transient vendor shall fail to register with the Township or otherwise fail to comply with the regulations established by the Board in this Resolution. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 505.94, any violation of this Resolution shall be a minor misdemeanor.

9. The Fiscal Officer shall notify the Office of the Cuyahoga County Prosecutor of the terms of this Resolution and provide a copy of this Resolution to the County Prosecutor.

Trustee Kress seconded the Motion, and thereupon, the votes in favor of this Resolution were recorded and reflected by the signatures hereto.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
